



FCCS Board Meeting Highlights

Dear Griffin Families,

Below are the highlights from the public board meeting that took place on Monday, February 6th, 2023.

1. Mr. Stephen Fraser from The Marketing Management Group Inc. provided an overview of his fundraising and grant writing services.
2. Ms. Salimeh Khaleeli was appointed as a Trustee with a one-year term (from February 6, 2023 and will end on February 29, 2024). Ms. Khaleeli has been an active volunteer in the library for years, and she was also the acting social committee chair before she was appointed. Mr. Robert Wells was appointed as a Trustee with a two-year term (from February 6, 2023 to February 28, 2025). Mr. Wells has extensive emergency management experience, and he is also the former facility committee chair. The Board welcomes these two new members and looks forward to working collaboratively with each other to serve the FCCS community.
3. The Board has received bids from three fundraising consultants, all of which would provide fundraising and grant writing services. The fundraising consultant topic was tabled to allow for input from the two new Board members. A formal vote will occur during the next Board meeting in March.
4. The Board unanimously approved the budget forecast, purchase of Latin textbooks for Grade 5, and funds for FCCS Talent Show and International Day.
5. The Board is finalizing the job description for the FCCS Executive Director position. The Executive Director job description will be approved during the March meeting.
6. The Board has received inquiries regarding the PE uniform from our community members. The Board had an initial discussion regarding the PE uniforms and will consult with all stakeholders to include admin, teachers, and the entire community, to determine what the next step is.
